

FDG Salmon & Sea Trout Fly Tying Course**Aurora Cascade Treble or Double****Pattern / Materials**

Hook	#8 Gold Esmond Drury style long shank Treble or DE Black Double
Silk	Fire Orange 8/0
Tag	Globrite Green #12 or UNI-floss Neon Hot Green & Small or Medium Oval Gold Tinsel
Tail	15 strands bright Yellow Bucktail & Hot Orange Bucktail
Tail flash	3 strands Krystal Silver Flash or Krystal Mirror Flash
Rib	Small or Medium Copper Wire
Body	Large or Medium Gold Holographic flat Tinsel
Hackle 1	Yellow Cock Hackle
Wing	Grey Squirrel Tail hair
Hackle 2	Orange Cock Hackles
Cheeks	Pair of Jungle Cock Eyes
Head	Globrite Red #4

Method

1. Mount hook in vice by one hook with shank horizontal
2. Wind on silk 2mm behind eye.
3. Tie in both Tags and bind down to bend.
4. Wind 4 turns green tag, return between hooks and tie off
5. Wind 4 turns gold tag further down, return between hooks and tie off. Trim to body length.
6. Catch in tail (twice hook length) and Krystal flash with tight touching turns down shank to bend.
7. Bind down tail and tags along full length of shank
8. On way back down, tie in Rib wire under shank, and bind down
9. Tie in body tinsel, and return thread to tail position
10. Return thread to 3-4mm behind eye.
11. Form body with overlapping tinsel and bind down. Remove tag end.
12. Wind 4 – 5 turns rib and bind down. Remove tag end.
13. Tie in yellow hackle by tip and wind 2-3 turns folded.
14. Trim hair to length, coat butt ends with superglue and tie in wing about 1.5x shank length
15. Bind down butts of wing and tidy up.
16. Tie in Orange Hackle by tip and wind 2-3 turns, tie off and trim waste
17. Tie in pair of Jungle Cock eyes on top and bottom, tie off and trim waste.
18. Whip finish black head to form small head
19. Tie in Globrite Red #4 and whip finish to form small bullet shaped head.
20. Varnish 2 coats 24 hrs apart.
